

R.C.I.A

The Rite Of Christian Initiation (R.C.I.A.) Program is for adults interested in becoming members of the Roman Catholic Church, adult Roman Catholics who would like to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation, and Catholics interested in Adult Education. Classes begin in the fall.

MARRIAGE:

Arrangements should be made at least six months in advance with a priest.

SICK CALLS:

Communion is taken to the shut-ins, once a month. Call the Rectory Office during office hours to have your name included.

To be a sponsor for Baptism, the sponsor needs to be confirmed. Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation are the sacraments of initiation. 
